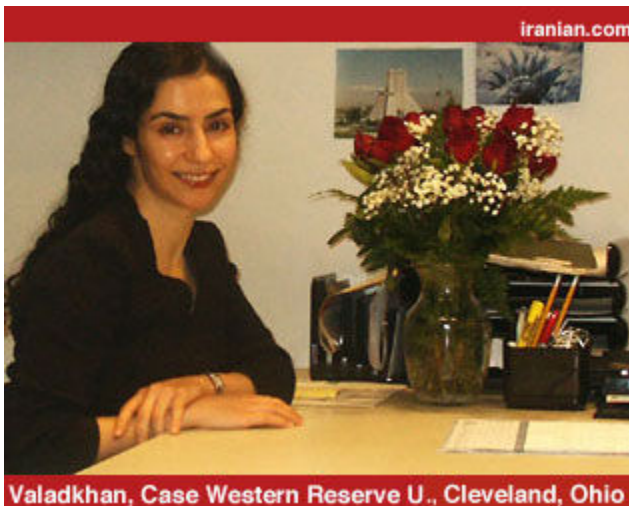
### Busy Man!
